On Friday 4<sup>th</sup> June and during the term break the Kindergartens are open for children to attend on their usual days. Most families however are able to enjoy the time together and to give their children a break from the busy kindergarten days.

Usually only a small number of children are attending Rambling Rose and are supervised by the teachers rostered on for the day, providing an outdoor programme at the back end of the school's grounds. At this time of the year, children need to arrive dressed in full rain gear, (gumboots rain pants, raincoat) and warm layers, including a warm hat. Please drop the children off at the Michael Hut (blue building at the end of the driveway, by the sports field) and don't forget the water bottle and a well filled and landfill free lunchbox for your child. Should you be arriving late, the group will be on their way, but you are welcome to go for a stroll and to listen for little voices, giving away where they are heading to.

The teachers of the day will make the call, if children need to rest or nap, or indeed need shelter from stormy conditions in one of the kindergarten rooms.

At 3pm the group will return to the Michael Hut, ready to go home.

Please park your car at the end of the driveway when dropping off and picking up, meet the teachers on the Michael Hut deck and sign the attendance sheets.

For those of you who are newer to Rose Ring Kindergartens, please check with your child's teacher, if you do need care between the terms, but are unsure how your little one will cope with the change of teacher, with other children and an unfamiliar setting.
